news 24/7 for the school's new grading scale, which raised controversy across the globe. Teachers were setting essays on fire, parents were acting like Raiders' fans after a loss; and students threatened to throw the school rock through the cafeteria window. Now, Principal Cliff Hardison is trying it again. Hardison has recently developed an allnew grading system that assesses students with symbols rather than letters.

In a recent press conference with President Barack Obama, Hardison released a prototype of his innovative grading

scale. A's have turned into smiley faces, B's have become stars, C's have switched to cows, D's are represented by dogs, and F's are only written with invisible ink. Obama's reaction was nothing but positive. He shook Hardison's hand, remarking, "This will fit right in with my Race to the Top initiative. Nothing against cows or dogs, but I do not want to see too many of those on our new recycled-paper report cards." Hardison responded with a chuckle, "And I can guarantee you will not see any

A representative from Brown University said, "We think Principal Hardison is taking a huge step into the future. Many high schools produce uptight students that colleges are sick and tired of

# Obama buys Facebook for a cool \$50 billion

In a surprise deal that removed the fragile separation between politics and cyberspace, President Barack Obama formally purchased the popular social networking site, Facebook, from CEO and founder Mark Zuckerburg with fifty billion dollars of the government's tax money. After many years of constantly obsessing over this anonymous sibling he decided to switch his focus to competing in Irish Olympic Games.


and burning all the old dolls of the students that have graduated. They wear long black coats with hoods to disguise their identity while they are igniting the fire.
